- By 2050 all buildings must be net zero across the whole life cycle

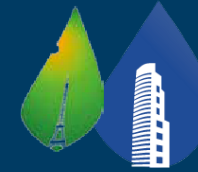

- Making the case of action by other parties to accelerate heat decarbonisation

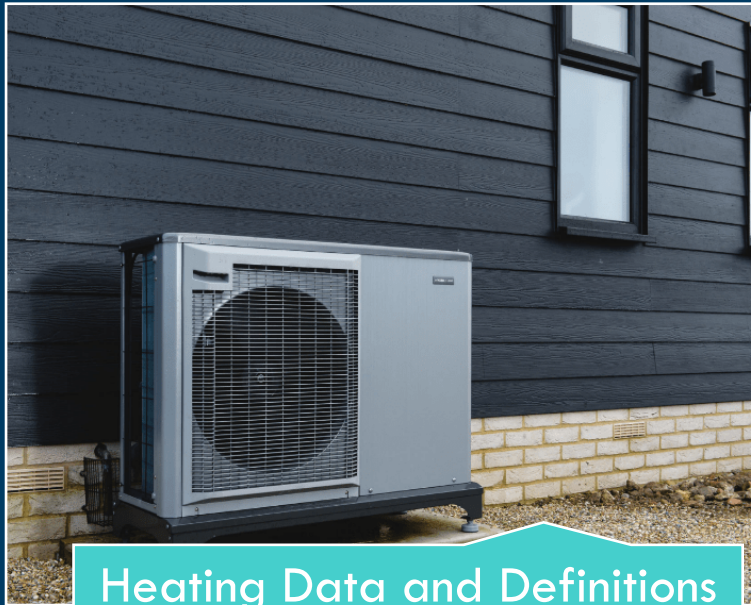

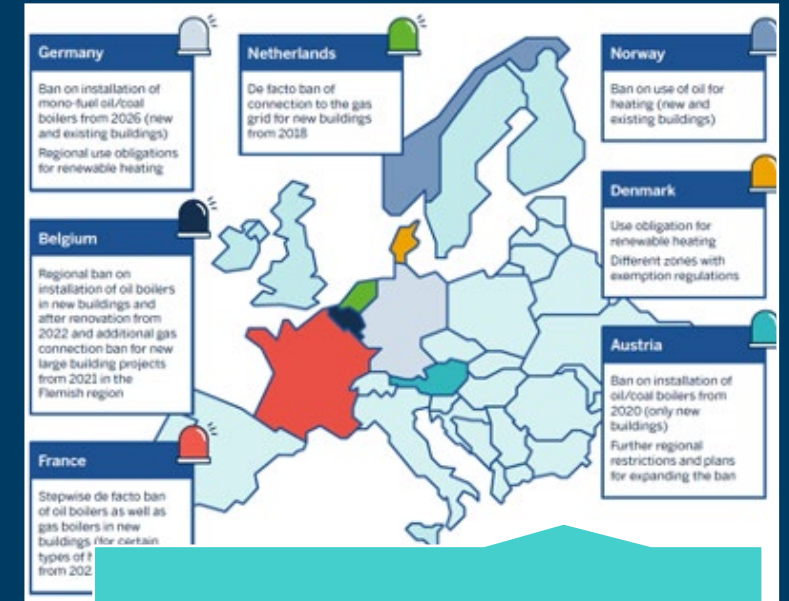
